



IMPORTANT NOTICE ETDP LEGACY QUALIFICATIONS/UNIT STANDARDS AND OCCUPATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS/SKILLS PROGRAMMES

We are not sure whether you are aware of the replacement of the legacy qualifications and unit standards, (issued prior to the establishment of the QCT and OQSF frameworks), with the occupational qualifications, which are designed to align with the current industry needs, educational practices, and regulatory requirements.

In saying this, Legacy qualifications will remain creditworthy and continue to retain their value and be recognised in the industry, in the future. All credits earned are recorded on the National Record Database (NLRD) and stand for always – they will not lapse.

However, it is most important to note that all new registrations must be uploaded on the ETDP system and registered prior to 30 June 2024 – these enrolments will have the usual prescribed timeframe to finish, but one must be aware that assessment, internal moderation and external moderation by the Seta must be conducted timeously. All achievements and downloading of Statements of Results and Certificates must be done **before 30 June 2027**. No access to any Legacy qualifications or unit standards can be sourced or downloaded from the system after 30 June 2027.

To confirm:

- **Registration/enrolment on the ETDP Seta system for any legacy qualification/skills programme/unit standard, must be done before 30 June 2024.**
- **All achievements, assessments, internal moderation, Seta external moderation and retrieval of Statements of Results and Certificates, to be done before 30 June 2027.**

Learners intending to do the Moderator programme, must be in possession of an ETDPSETA Statement of Results reflecting the Assessor unit standard, before June 2024, to be allowed to register for the unit standard based Moderator unit standard. Therefore, we urge those learners that are busy with the Assessor Portfolio of Evidence to submit as soon as possible to ensure that their results for the Assessor unit standard are endorsed by the ETDPSETA in time to be registered for the Moderator unit standard.
